Hi Geoff,

I hope you are doing well!

I was just thinking recently about the opportunity to explore the impact of penicillin allergy on AMR in Australia. It's often been in the "too hard basket" because the numbers required would be so large. However, we have recently started a national registry for penicillin allergy assessment and Delabelling (national antibiotic allergy network) and likely to have accumulated 4000 patients over the next 2-3 years. One possibility would be to do a data linkage exercise with AGAR, if there was some identifier we could use, and obviously with the appropriate ethics/governance. I thought I would reach out to see if this would be of interest? It would certainly be the first study to look at impact of Delabelling on AMR rather than just association studies. Obviously happy to chat further
